

THE 1812 WOODHOUSE CENSUS

One of the most important documents for Norfolk County genealogical research is the 1812 census record for Woodhouse Township. It is unique in being the first personal census known to survive for any part of Norfolk County. It is also the only personal census with names and ages of family members available before the 1851 universal census for Ontario (Canada West).

This 1812 census is a partial census only. Researchers believe that only a part of Woodhouse Township was included, and several old family names known to be in Woodhouse then do not appear.

The source is a document entitled "Census of the Township of Woodhouse for 1812. No. 4. Strong vs. Bostwick. Chancery. Exhibited before me this 25 / 30 July and marked R ... ". It is in the collections of the Regional Collection, D. B. Weldon Library, University of Western Ontario, London, Ontario.

We are much indebted to Mr. Edward Phelps, Regional Collection Librarian, for calling our attention to the document several years ago. He arranged for a microfilm of the census to be donated to the Norfolk Historical Society. In the recent past, he also provided a photocopied copy of the document which allowed the reproduction of the old handwriting used in this booklet. The census is published with the permission of the Regional Collection.

A previous version of the 1812 Woodhouse census was published in two earlier editions by the Norfolk Historical Society some years ago. The present format is much preferred, since it allows the researcher to appreciate the many difficulties of the original handwriting. To fit the page size of this booklet, some of the pages were reduced in size.

Transcriber is William Yeager, Curator of the Eva Brook Donly Museum. Familiarity with old Woodhouse and Norfolk County names was a great help in attempting the transcript. Invaluable assistance also came from comparison with an earlier transcript by NHS Archives volunteer Mrs. Harriet Walker, a researcher with deep roots in Woodhouse Township.

Square brackets, sometimes also accompanied by a question mark, are used to indicate difficult handwriting that makes identification questionable.

Researchers should be ready to accept that some problems with original misspellings of names may very well exist. The recorder undoubtedly made some errors, especially with difficult names that an illiterate informant may have himself been unable to spell. Ages could also vary somewhat from the age a more precise family bible or tombstone record might provide. The use of diminutive or familiar names is common - Sally for Sarah, Betsey for Elizabeth, Polly for Mary, and so on.

A sampling of very brief editorial notes are included with the transcript, taken from researches by both Mrs. Walker and Wm. Yeager. These are meant to be helpful, but they by no means reflect the much larger amount of information that can be added from other records such as tombstones, church records, family bibles, newspaper obituaries, family history books and such.
